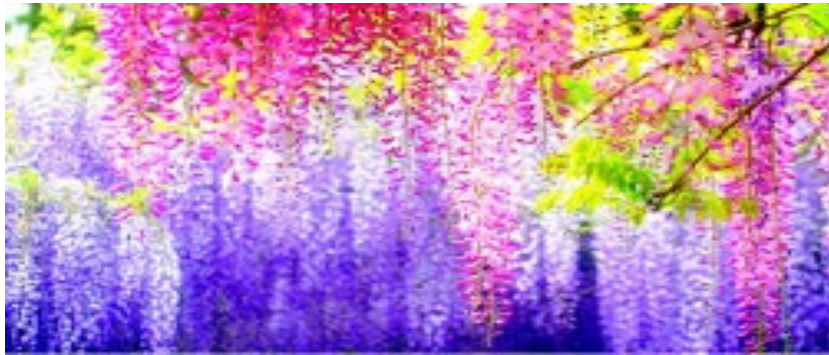


Our role is not only to ease suffering, bind up
